6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to hospital facilities; requiring  
8 certain individuals to report certain injuries to law  
9 enforcement; granting immunity from civil liability  
10 to certain individuals for compliance with this act;  
11 providing for codification; and providing an  
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-725 of Title 63, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. It is the duty of any person conducting or operating a  
18 hospital, or any physician or nurse as soon as treatment permits, to  
19 notify the local law enforcement agency of that jurisdiction upon  
20 the application for treatment of a person who is not accompanied by  
21 a law enforcement officer, when it reasonably appears that the  
22 person requesting treatment has received:

- 23 1. Any injury resulting from the discharge of a firearm; or  
24 2. Any injury sustained in the commission of or as a victim of  
a criminal offense.

1 B. Any hospital, physician or nurse shall forever be held  
2 harmless from any civil liability for their reasonable compliance  
3 with the provisions of this section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.

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
