6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to substance abuse services; amending
8 43A O.S. 2021, Section 3-415, which relates to
9 Certified Services for the Alcohol- and Drug-
10 Dependent; requiring Board of Mental Health and
11 Substance Abuse Services to consider certain
12 accreditation as proof of compliance with applicable
13 standards of Board; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2021, Section 3-415, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 3-415. A. 1. The Board of Mental Health and Substance
18 Abuse Services shall promulgate rules and standards for
19 certification for private facilities and organizations which provide
20 treatment, counseling, recovery and rehabilitation services directed
21 toward alcohol- and drug-dependent persons. These facilities and
22 organizations shall be known as "Certified Services for the Alcohol-
23 and Drug-Dependent". Only certified facilities may receive and
24 assist alcohol- and drug-dependent persons by providing treatment,
25 recovery support and rehabilitation.

1 2. Any person violating the requirement that only certified
2 facilities may receive and assist alcohol- and drug-dependent
3 persons by providing treatment to alcohol- and drug-dependent
4 persons, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Except
5 as otherwise provided in this section, no substance abuse treatment
6 program shall operate or continue to operate unless the facility
7 complies with the rules promulgated by the Board and is certified as
8 required by this section.

9 B. Applications for certification as a certified service for
10 the alcohol- and drug-dependent person pursuant to the provisions of
11 this section shall be made to the Department of Mental Health and
12 Substance Abuse Services on prescribed forms.

13 C. The Board, or the Commissioner of Mental Health and
14 Substance Abuse Services upon delegation by the Board, may certify
15 the facility for a period of not more than thirty-six (36) months
16 subject to renewal as provided.

17 D. The Board, or the Commissioner of Mental Health and
18 Substance Abuse Services upon delegation by the Board, may postpone,
19 deny renewal of, revoke, or suspend the certification of the
20 facility for failure to comply with rules and standards promulgated
21 by the Board.

22 E. The following are exempt from the provisions of the Oklahoma
23 Alcohol and Drug Abuse Services Act:

1 1. Individual persons in private practice as licensed
2 physicians, licensed psychologists, licensed social workers,
3 registered nurses, licensed professional counselors, licensed
4 marriage and family therapists, licensed behavioral practitioners,
5 individual members of the clergy, licensed alcohol or drug abuse
6 counselors and certified alcohol or drug abuse counselors. The
7 exemption shall apply only to individual professional persons in
8 their private practice and not to any treatment facility operated by
9 the person;

10 2. Properly licensed hospitals, psychiatric and medical
11 surgical facilities;

12 3. Programs or facilities operated by a state agency;

13 4. Programs conducted and facilities operated by Alcoholics
14 Anonymous;

15 5. Programs conducted and facilities operated by the Salvation
16 Army;

17 6. Faith-based, nonresidential recovery programs;

18 7. Residential recovery-based programs with a resident capacity
19 of less than twelve;

20 8. Residential recovery and recovery support programs that are
21 not collocated with certified treatment programs. However, the
22 Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services shall offer
23 voluntary certification for those resident recovery and recovery
24

1 support programs that are not collocated with certified treatment
2 programs that desire Department certification; or

3 9. Services provided by a health center as defined in the
4 Public Health Service Act, 42 U.S.C., Section 254b, except for
5 services listed in Levels 2.1 through 4 of the Levels of Care
6 described in the American Society of Addiction Medicine Criteria.

7 F. Certified services for the alcohol- or drug-dependent person
8 shall comply with standards adopted by the Board. Such standards
9 shall require that treatment and therapeutic methods shall be in
10 compliance with:

11 1. The Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare
12 Organizations (JCAHO);

13 2. The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities
14 (CARF);

15 3. The Council on Accreditation (COA); or

16 4. Approved medical and professional standards as determined by
17 the Board.

18 G. The Board shall consider accreditation from JCAHO, CARF, or
19 COA for the services being provided as proof of compliance with
20 applicable standards adopted by the Board, as determined by the
21 Board.

22 H. Any facility or organization certified to provide certified
23 services shall cooperate with inspection personnel of the state and
24 shall promptly file all reports required by the Board.

1 ~~H.~~ I. All claims by and accomplishments publicized by any
2 applicant for certification or any certified alcohol- or drug-
3 dependent organization, including but not limited to consumer count
4 and success rates, shall be documented and verifiable by the Board.

5 ~~I.~~ J. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
6 Services is authorized to establish and collect certification and
7 renewal fees for certification of private facilities and
8 organizations which provide treatment, counseling and rehabilitation
9 services directed toward alcohol- and drug-dependent persons, as
10 provided in Section 3-324 of this title.

11 ~~J.~~ K. Any materials or information received by the Department
12 from an applicant regarding the applicant's financial status shall
13 not be construed to be open records pursuant to the Oklahoma Open
14 Records Act.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
