10	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 3007, as
11	last amended by Section 119, Chapter 15, O.S.L. 2013 (74 O.S. Supp.
12	2019, Section 3007), is amended to read as follows:
13	Section 3007. A. Whenever Except as provided in subsection C
14	of this section, whenever the State of Oklahoma or any of its
15	agencies intends to procure any product or service included in the
16	procurement schedule, that entity shall secure the product or
17	service from a qualified nonprofit agency providing employment to
18	people with severe disabilities at the fair market price determined
19	by the Committee if the product or service is available within the
20	period required by the entity.
21	B. An agency of this state shall not evade the intent and
22	meaning of this section by slight variations from standards adopted
23	by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

C. Provided, the requirements of this section shall not apply
 to the:

<u>1. The</u> procurement of janitorial services by the Oklahoma State
Bureau of Investigation. The Bureau shall conduct background
investigations and national criminal history record checks on
companies and individuals with which it contracts to provide
janitorial services; or

8 <u>2. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs for any purchase</u>
 9 <u>made from a veteran-owned business as defined in Section 63.22 of</u>
 10 Title 72 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

When the fair market price for a product or service approved 11 D. 12 by the Committee exceeds a current market price for the same product or service, and such lower market price has been verified by the 13 agency through compliance with the fair market analysis process 14 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, the 15 state use contracting officer may grant a temporary exception to a 16 requesting agency so that the agency may purchase the product or 17 service from the vendor offering the lower market price. 18 The temporary exception shall automatically expire when a new fair 19 market price is established by the State Use Committee. 20

21 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 23 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 24 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
