An Act relating to the Department of Corrections; requiring the expenditure of certain funds in certain amounts for certain purposes; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Department of Corrections

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of Corrections in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1125 of the 2nd Session of the 59th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Corrections shall expend Three Million Seventy-four Dollars (\$3,000,074.00) to increase per diem rates at private correctional facilities for medium security inmates to Fifty-three Dollars and thirty-one cents (\$53.31) per day and for protective custody inmates to Sixty Dollars and one cent (\$60.01) per day.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
