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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.60 of Title 70, unless

there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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- A. 1. The 1907 Project is hereby established as an advisory committee to promote patriotic education and increase awareness of Oklahoma values.
- 2. For the purposes of this section, "patriotic education"
  means:
  - a. presentation of the history of Oklahoma's founding and foundational principles,
  - b. examination of how Oklahoma has grown closer to those principles throughout its history, and
  - c. explanation of why commitment to those principles is beneficial and justified.
- B. The 1907 Project shall be comprised of nine (9) members to be appointed as follows:
- 1. Three members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;
- 2. Three members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and
- 3. Three members appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall serve as chair of the advisory committee.
- C. Appointments to the 1907 Project shall be made within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this act. Members of the 1907 Project shall serve two-year terms. A member may be removed by the appointing authority for inefficiency, neglect of duty, or malfeasance. Vacancies shall be filled by the appointing authority.

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- D. The chair of the 1907 Project shall convene as many meetings as may be required to perform the duties imposed upon the advisory committee and shall coordinate and direct the activities of the advisory committee.
  - E. The 1907 Project shall:
- 1. Promote awareness among the residents of this state of the following as they relate to the history of prosperity and democratic freedom in this state:
  - a. Oklahoma history,
  - b. the founding documents of this state,
  - c. the founders of this state, and
  - d. state civics;
- 2. Advise the Governor on the core principles of the founding of this state and how those principles further enrich the lives of its residents;
- 3. Facilitate the development and implementation of the Gubernatorial 1907 Award to recognize student knowledge of Oklahoma history;
- 4. Advise state agencies with regard to their efforts to ensure patriotic education is provided to the public at state parks, battlefields, monuments, museums, installations, landmarks, cemeteries, and other places important to the founding of this state, as appropriate and consistent with applicable law; and

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- 5. Facilitate, advise on, and promote other activities to support public knowledge of and patriotic education on the founding of this state, as appropriate and consistent with applicable law.
- F. To carry out the provisions of subsection E of this section, the 1907 Project may solicit statements and contributions from intellectual and cultural figures.
- G. Members of the 1907 Project shall receive no compensation or travel reimbursement.
- H. The State Department of Education shall provide staff and administrative support for the 1907 Project.
- I. 1. No later than July 1, 2023, the 1907 Project shall provide a pamphlet to the Department of Public Safety that explains the significance of policy decisions made by this state that promote liberty and freedom for businesses and families. The pamphlet shall include:
  - a. an overview of Oklahoma history and civics,
  - b. the legacy of economic prosperity in this state, and
  - c. the abundant opportunities for businesses and families in this state.
- 2. The Department of Public Safety shall provide the pamphlet required by this subsection to persons issued a valid Class D license as provided for in Sections 6-102 or 6-105 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

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1 J. 1. No later than July 1, 2023, the 1907 Project shall submit a report to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The report shall include:

- a description of the activities of the 1907 Project,
- b. the findings and recommendations of the 1907 Project,
- C. a plan that identifies the best method of carrying out the provisions of subsection E of this section,
- d. any proposals for legislation, and
- any other matter the 1907 Project considers е. appropriate.
- The 1907 Project may prepare subsequent reports as it deems appropriate.
- 3. Reports submitted pursuant to this subsection shall be posted on the State Department of Education's website.
- Κ. The 1907 Project created in this section shall end no later than July 1, 2037.
  - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
