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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 1210.189, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 1210.189. A. A board of education of a public school
19	district or a technology center school district, the governing board
20	of a private school, the board of regents of an institution within
21	The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, the governing board
22	of a private postsecondary educational institution, the Oklahoma
23	State Regents for Higher Education, the State Board of Education <u>,</u> or
24 27	the State Board of Career and Technology Education shall not:

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1 1. Require a vaccination against Coronavirus disease 2019 2 (COVID-19) as a condition of admittance to or attendance of the 3 school or institution;

<sup>4</sup> 2. Require a vaccine passport as a condition of admittance to
 <sup>5</sup> or attendance of the school or institution; or

6 3. Implement a mask mandate for students who have not been
7 vaccinated against COVID-19.

B. As used in this section, "vaccine passport" means
 documentation that an individual has been vaccinated against COVID 10
 19.

C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to apply to any public or private healthcare setting.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2021, Section 1210.190, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1210.190. A. A board of education of a public school district or a technology center school district <u>or the governing</u> <u>board of a private school</u> may only implement a mandate to wear a mask or any other medical device as provided in this subsection.

19 1. A board of education of a public school district or a 20 technology center school district <u>or the governing board of a</u> 21 <u>private school</u> may only implement a mandate to wear a mask or any 22 other medical device after consultation with the local county health 23 department or city-county health department within the jurisdiction 24 of where the board is located and when the jurisdiction of where the

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1 board is located is under a current state of emergency declared by 2 the Governor. 3 2. The mandate shall explicitly list the purposes for the 4 mandate. 5 3. The mandate shall reference the specific masks or medical 6 devices that would meet the requirements of the mandate. 7 4. Any mandate to implement wearing a mask or any other medical 8 device shall be reconsidered at each regularly scheduled board 9 meeting. 10 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022. 11 SECTION 4.
