6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state employment; prohibiting
8 hiring discrimination based on vaccination status;
9 prohibiting certain state entities from mandating
10 vaccination; providing for codification; providing an
11 effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-1.22 of Title 74, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 No state agency or sub-contractor of a state agency that hires
17 individuals for full-time or part-time employment for this state,
18 shall discriminate against candidates based on their vaccination
19 status while being considered for employment.

20 These state agencies or sub-contractors shall not mandate
21 vaccines as a prerequisite for any type of employment for this
22 state.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
