15	No state agency or sub-contractor of a state agency that hires
16	individuals for full-time or part-time employment for this state,

18	shall discriminate against candidates based on their vaccination
19	status while being considered for employment.
	These state agencies or sub-contractors shall not mandate
20	vaccines as a prerequisite for any type of employment for this
21	state.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
