13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-136 of Title 70, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. The State Board of Career and Technology Education may
18	establish courses in the area of hydrogen energy. The courses may
19	include but are not limited to the following topics:
20	1. Hydrogen energy basics;
21	2. Hydrogen energy-related equipment manufacturing and
22	maintenance;
23	3. Hydrogen energy infrastructure; and
24	4. Hydrogen energy safety.

1	B. The State Board of Career and Technology Education may
2	consult the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and the Department of
3	Labor in establishing courses that meet the workforce needs of the
4	hydrogen energy sector in this state.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.
6	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
