18	certifies the current officeholder is unopposed or re-elected, there
19	shall be a hiring freeze by the office or agency of statewide office
20	holders pursuant to this section.
21	B. In the event the elected official deems it is necessary for
22	the operation of the office or agency, an employee may be hired upon
23	approval by a governing board or the appropriate cabinet secretary
24	with authority over such office or agency.
