17	daylight saving time year-round, this state shall adopt daylight
18	saving time as the year-round standard of time for the entire state
19	and all its political subdivisions.
20	B. This section shall not be construed to affect the standard
21	time established by federal law governing the movement of common
22	carriers engaged in interstate commerce or the time for performance
23	of an act by an officer or department of the United States, as
