NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 90.28 of Title 25, unless there 21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 22 If a federal law is passed that authorizes states to observe 23 Α. 24 daylight saving time year-round, this state shall adopt daylight

1	saving time as the year-round standard of time for the entire state
2	and all its political subdivisions.
3	B. This section shall not be construed to affect the standard
4	time established by federal law governing the movement of common
5	carriers engaged in interstate commerce or the time for performance
6	of an act by an officer or department of the United States, as
7	established by a statute, lawful order, rule, or regulation of the
8	United States or an agency thereof.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon the enactment of a
10	federal law that permits states to enter upon and permanently
11	observe daylight saving time.
