5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to the State Auditor and Inspector  
7 Revolving Fund; modifying amount to be deposited in  
8 the General Revenue Fund; updating statutory  
9 language; providing an effective date; and declaring  
an emergency.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2021 Section 227.9 is  
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 227.9. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a  
14 revolving fund for the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector to  
15 be designated the "State Auditor and Inspector Revolving Fund". The  
16 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year  
17 limitations, and shall consist of all money paid to and received by  
18 the State Auditor and Inspector from state agencies, boards and  
19 commissions authorized by statute to pay the expense of audits and  
20 consulting services, money received for performance of audits and  
21 consulting services pursuant to contract entered into under the  
22 authority of Section 227.8 of this title, funds received from state  
23 agencies, boards and commissions receiving federal grants of funds  
24 which require periodic audits under ~~said~~ the grants or any federal

1 regulations, all money received from counties, cities, towns and  
2 public trusts in payment of audit expense, funds appropriated to  
3 state agencies, boards and commissions for payment of audit expense,  
4 and fees collected pursuant to Section 212A of this title. All  
5 monies accruing to the credit of ~~said~~ the fund are hereby  
6 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Office of the  
7 State Auditor and Inspector for expenses necessary for the  
8 performance of duties imposed upon the Office of the State Auditor  
9 and Inspector by law. Expenditures from ~~said~~ the fund shall be made  
10 upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as  
11 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and  
12 Enterprise Services for approval and payment. The State Auditor and  
13 Inspector shall at the close of each fiscal year pay into the  
14 General Revenue Fund of the state any unencumbered balance remaining  
15 in ~~said~~ the revolving fund in excess of ~~Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand~~  
16 ~~Dollars (\$850,000.00)~~ Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00).

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

18 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
21 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
