18	shall be responsible for planning and supervising the preservation
19	and restoration of the interior and exterior of the State Capitol
20	Building, hereinafter referred to as the Capitol, and the Governor's
21	Mansion. The Commission shall control the display of art objects in
22	public areas of the Capitol and the Governor's Mansion.
23	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.
