12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A pharmacist licensed by the State Board of Pharmacy may
16	prescribe nonprescription drugs in accordance with state and federal
17	laws and rules that are to be used for compounding of
18	nonprescription ingredients. The prescription shall only be valid
19	at the pharmacy where such pharmacist is employed or under contract.
20	The Board may promulgate rules to implement this section.
21	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
