



- 1        2. The availability, effectiveness, and known contraindications  
2 of the influenza immunization;
- 3        3. Causes and symptoms of influenza; and
- 4        4. The means by which influenza is spread.

5 Making available the appropriate and current Vaccine Information  
6 Statement as provided by the Centers for Disease Control and  
7 Prevention shall be deemed compliance with this subsection.

8        B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an  
9 assisted living center to provide or pay for any immunization  
10 against influenza for its residents.

11        C. No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or  
12 damage caused by any act or omission resulting from providing, or  
13 the lack of providing, educational information pursuant to this act.

14        D. The assisted living center's license shall not be affected  
15 due to the providing or lack of providing the educational  
16 information pursuant to this act.

17        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
