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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-890.7a of Title 63, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. Each assisted living center shall annually provide to each
21	of its residents, no later than September 1 of each year,
22	educational information on influenza disease. Such information
23	shall include, but not be limited to:
24	1. The risks associated with influenza disease;

2. The availability, effectiveness, and known contraindications
 2 of the influenza immunization;

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3. Causes and symptoms of influenza; and

4 4. The means by which influenza is spread.

5 Making available the appropriate and current Vaccine Information
6 Statement as provided by the Centers for Disease Control and
7 Prevention shall be deemed compliance with this subsection.

8 B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an
9 assisted living center to provide or pay for any immunization
10 against influenza for its residents.

11 C. No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or 12 damage caused by any act or omission resulting from providing, or 13 the lack of providing, educational information pursuant to this act.

D. The assisted living center's license shall not be affected due to the providing or lack of providing the educational information pursuant to this act.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
