14	A. Contingent upon the provision of appropriated funds
15	designated for such purpose, the State Board of Education shall
16	solicit proposals for pilot projects that facilitate the
17	coordination of health and educational services to families that are
18	eligible for Medicaid. Proposals may include services from county
19	health departments, pediatric physicians and school personnel to
20	address the needs of children under five (5) years of age, students
21	who have dropped out of school and adult members of families. The
22	Board shall consider proposals in cooperation with personnel from
23	the Department of Human Services, the State Department of Health and
24	the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.
