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6 An Act relating to the State Board of Education;  
7 directing the Board to solicit proposals for certain  
8 pilot projects contingent upon certain funds;  
9 providing criteria for proposals; directing the Board  
10 to consider proposals in certain cooperation;  
11 directing the Board in conjunction with certain  
12 departments to determine certain criteria and  
13 establish a process to consider proposals; directing  
14 consideration of proposals on a statewide competitive  
15 basis; providing for promulgation of rules; providing  
16 for codification; providing an effective date; and  
17 declaring an emergency.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100e of Title 70, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Contingent upon the provision of appropriated funds  
designated for such purpose, the State Board of Education shall  
solicit proposals for pilot projects that facilitate the  
coordination of health and educational services to families that are  
eligible for Medicaid. Proposals may include services from county  
health departments, pediatric physicians and school personnel to  
address the needs of children under five (5) years of age, students

1 who have dropped out of school and adult members of families. The  
2 Board shall consider proposals in cooperation with personnel from  
3 the Department of Human Services, the State Department of Health and  
4 the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

5 B. The State Board of Education, in conjunction with personnel  
6 from the Department of Human Services, the State Department of  
7 Health and the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, shall determine pilot  
8 project criteria and establish a process for the consideration of  
9 proposals. Proposals shall be considered on a statewide competitive  
10 basis.

11 C. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to  
12 implement the provisions of this section.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
15 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
