An Act relating to the State Board of Education; directing the Board to solicit proposals for certain pilot projects contingent upon certain funds; providing criteria for proposals; directing the Board to consider proposals in certain cooperation; directing the Board in conjunction with certain departments to determine certain criteria and establish a process to consider proposals; directing consideration of proposals on a statewide competitive basis; providing for promulgation of rules; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100e of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Contingent upon the provision of appropriated funds designated for such purpose, the State Board of Education shall solicit proposals for pilot projects that facilitate the coordination of health and educational services to families that are eligible for Medicaid. Proposals may include services from county health departments, pediatric physicians and school personnel to address the needs of children under five (5) years of age, students

- who have dropped out of school and adult members of families. The
  Board shall consider proposals in cooperation with personnel from
  the Department of Human Services, the State Department of Health and
  the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.
  - B. The State Board of Education, in conjunction with personnel from the Department of Human Services, the State Department of Health and the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, shall determine pilot project criteria and establish a process for the consideration of proposals. Proposals shall be considered on a statewide competitive basis.
  - C. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
- 13 | SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.
  - SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
