6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to gun control; prohibiting public
8 officers and employees from using public monies to
9 promote gun control; providing a list of prohibited
actions; providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24.5 of Title 51, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any public officer or the employees of a public officer shall
17 not use public monies for the advocacy or promotion of gun control
18 and shall be specifically prohibited from doing any of the
19 following:

20 1. Using publicity or propaganda for the purposes of advocating
21 or promoting gun control or preparing, distributing or using any
22 kit, pamphlet, booklet, publication, electronic communication or
23 radio, television or video presentation designed to support or

1 defeat the enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation
2 or administrative action relating to gun control;

3 2. Paying the salary or expenses of any grant or contract
4 recipient or agent acting on behalf of the recipient, if the grant
5 or contract is related to any activity designed to influence the
6 enactment of legislation, an ordinance, rule, regulation or
7 administrative action relating to gun control; or

8 3. Advocating or promoting any proposed, pending or future
9 federal, state or local tax increase relating to gun control, or any
10 proposed, pending or future requirement or restriction on any legal
11 consumer product, including the sale and marketing of the legal
12 consumer product relating to the advocacy or promotion of gun
13 control.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
