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- 4. "Nonappropriated state agency" means any state agency that does not receive funding through the annual legislative appropriations process;
- 5. "Shared services" means those state agency functions which are or could be provided through:

 - b. the programs, services, software or processes specified in subsection B of Section 35.6 of this title; and
- 6. "State agency" means any office, elected or appointed officer, bureau, board, commission, counsel, unit, division, body, authority or institution of the executive branch of state government, excluding institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, the Oklahoma Municipal Power Authority, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the telecommunications network known as OneNet.
