6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to health agency administration;  
8 authorizing the Governor to select a Chief Financial  
9 and Budget Officer, subject to Senate confirmation  
10 and to fix certain salary; providing duties of the  
11 Chief Financial and Budget Officer; providing for  
12 codification; providing an effective date; and  
13 declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-201a of Title 43A, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Governor shall have the power and duty to select a Chief  
19 Financial and Budget Officer (CFBO) who shall serve as the financial  
20 officer of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse  
21 Services. The CFBO shall serve, subject to the confirmation of the  
22 Senate, at the pleasure of the Governor. The salary of the CFBO  
23 shall be fixed by the Governor.

24 B. The CFBO shall report to the Governor, to the Legislature  
and to the Board of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services on

1 all financial matters related to the Department of Mental Health and  
2 Substance Abuse Services including, but not limited to, presenting  
3 the Department's annual budget request at budget hearings.

4 C. All proposed expenditures of the Department, regardless of  
5 the funding source, shall require the approval of the CFBO.

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 162.1c of Title 56, unless there  
8 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 A. The Governor shall have the power and duty to select a Chief  
10 Financial and Budget Officer (CFBO) who shall serve as the financial  
11 officer of the Department of Human Services. The CFBO shall serve,  
12 subject to the confirmation of the Senate, at the pleasure of the  
13 Governor. The salary of the CFBO shall be fixed by the Governor.

14 B. The CFBO shall report to the Governor and to the Legislature  
15 on all financial matters related to the Department of Human  
16 Services, including but not limited to, presenting the Department's  
17 annual budget request at budget hearings.

18 C. All proposed expenditures of the Department, regardless of  
19 the funding source, shall require the approval of the CFBO.

20 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-105g of Title 63, unless there  
22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 A. The Governor shall have the power and duty to select a Chief  
24 Financial and Budget Officer (CFBO) who shall serve as the financial

1 officer of the State Department of Health. The CFBO shall serve,  
2 subject to the confirmation of the Senate, at the pleasure of the  
3 Governor. The salary of the CFBO shall be fixed by the Governor.

4 B. The CFBO shall report to the Governor, to the Legislature  
5 and to the State Board of Health on all financial matters related to  
6 the state Department of Health including, but not limited to,  
7 presenting the Department's annual budget request at budget  
8 hearings.

9 C. All proposed expenditures of the Department, regardless of  
10 the funding source, shall require the approval of the CFBO.

11 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5008.1 of Title 63, unless there  
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. The Governor shall have the power and duty to select a Chief  
15 Financial and Budget Officer (CFBO) who shall serve as the financial  
16 officer of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority. The CFBO shall  
17 serve, subject to the confirmation of the Senate, at the pleasure of  
18 the Governor. The salary of the CFBO shall be fixed by the  
19 Governor.

20 B. The CFBO shall report to the Governor, to the Legislature  
21 and to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board on all financial  
22 matters related to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority including, but  
23 not limited to, presenting the Department's annual budget request at  
24 budget hearings.

1 C. All proposed expenditures of the Department, regardless of  
2 the funding source, shall require the approval of the CFBO.

3 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

4 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
