  - C. All proposed expenditures of the Department, regardless of the funding source, shall require the approval of the CFBO.

- SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 162.1c of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. The Governor shall have the power and duty to select a Chief Financial and Budget Officer (CFBO) who shall serve as the financial officer of the Department of Human Services. The CFBO shall serve, subject to the confirmation of the Senate, at the pleasure of the Governor. The salary of the CFBO shall be fixed by the Governor.
- B. The CFBO shall report to the Governor and to the Legislature on all financial matters related to the Department of Human Services, including but not limited to, presenting the Department's annual budget request at budget hearings.
- C. All proposed expenditures of the Department, regardless of the funding source, shall require the approval of the CFBO.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-105g of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. The Governor shall have the power and duty to select a Chief Financial and Budget Officer (CFBO) who shall serve as the financial

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officer of the State Department of Health. The CFBO shall serve, subject to the confirmation of the Senate, at the pleasure of the Governor. The salary of the CFBO shall be fixed by the Governor.

- B. The CFBO shall report to the Governor, to the Legislature and to the State Board of Health on all financial matters related to the state Department of Health including, but not limited to, presenting the Department's annual budget request at budget hearings.
  - C. All proposed expenditures of the Department, regardless of the funding source, shall require the approval of the CFBO.
- SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5008.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
  - A. The Governor shall have the power and duty to select a Chief Financial and Budget Officer (CFBO) who shall serve as the financial officer of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority. The CFBO shall serve, subject to the confirmation of the Senate, at the pleasure of the Governor. The salary of the CFBO shall be fixed by the Governor.
- B. The CFBO shall report to the Governor, to the Legislature and to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board on all financial matters related to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority including, but not limited to, presenting the Department's annual budget request at budget hearings.

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        C. All proposed expenditures of the Department, regardless of
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    the funding source, shall require the approval of the CFBO.
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        SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
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        SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
    of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
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    declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
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    be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
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
