13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1160 of Title 59, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. For the purposes of this section:
17	1. "Casualty insurance" means insurance as defined pursuant to
18	Section 707 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
19	2. "Property insurance" means insurance as defined pursuant to
20	Section 704 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
21	3. "Roofing contractor" means a roofing contractor as defined
22	pursuant to paragraph 18 of Section 1151.2 of Title 59 of the
23	Oklahoma Statutes.
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B. Any roofing contractor providing services including but not limited to repair or improvement services to be paid from the proceeds of a property or casualty insurance policy shall not file an insurance claim on behalf of the insured without express written permission from the insured. Property and casualty insurance providers shall not accept claims from any other entity or person other than the insured for services under this subsection without express written permission from the insured permitting the submission of the claim.
