11	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

14	Notwithstanding any law or rule relating to any trade,
15	occupation or profession regulated under Title 59 of the Oklahoma
16	Statutes, no person or entity possessing a valid license or
17	certification generated through the Construction Industries Board or
18	from any board, committee or commission operating under the
19	enforcement authority of the Construction Industries Board shall be
20	required to state or provide their state-issued license or
21	certification number in any electronic advertisement or any radio,
22	television, telephone message or other auditory-type advertisement
23	published in this state.
24	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

1	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
