BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-126 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. 1. Each school district shall submit to the State

 Department of Education quarterly statements of expenditures using
 the Oklahoma Cost Accounting System, as adopted by the State Board
 of Education pursuant to Section 5-135 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma
 Statutes. Statements shall be submitted in accordance with a
 schedule prescribed by the Department.
- 2. The submission date for the final quarterly report of each year shall coincide with the submission date for the statement of actual income and expenditures required by Section 5-135.2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Submission of the final quarterly

1	report of each year shall constitute compliance with Section 5-135.2
2	of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
3	B. The State Department of Education shall submit the statements
