8	An Act relating to Cemetery Merchandise Trust Act;
9	amending 36 O.S. 2021, Section 7122, which relates to definitions; modifying definitions; and providing an
10	effective date.

12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 36 O.S. 2021, Section 7122, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 7122. As used in the Cemetery Merchandise Trust Act:
16	1. "Cemetery merchandise" means markers, memorials, vases,
17	memorial vases, monuments, equipment, crypts, and niches or outer
18	enclosures. Cemetery merchandise shall not include the sale of
19	lands or interests therein as grave lots or grave spaces; burial or
20	interment rights; and delivered or installed crypts $_{ au}$ or niches $_{ au au}$
21	outer enclosures;
22	2. "Purchase price" means the gross <u>net</u> amount to be paid for
23	cemetery merchandise under the provisions of a prepaid cemetery
24	merchandise contract. Purchase price shall not include finance

charges, sales tax, charges for real property interests, or charges for credit life insurance, or perpetual care fees;

- 3. "Prepaid cemetery merchandise contract" means any agreement for the sale of cemetery merchandise by an organization which requires payment of the purchase price, in whole or in part, prior to delivery of the cemetery merchandise, which agreement is entered into from and after November 1, 1989;
- 4. "Minimum funding requirement" means that portion of the purchase price equal to one hundred ten percent (110%) one hundred percent (100%) of the wholesale cost, plus delivery charges, of the cemetery merchandise covered in a prepaid cemetery merchandise contract;
- 5. "Organization" means any individual, firm, partnership, trust, corporation, association or entity. Organization shall not include state, county, municipal, township, rural community, religious, fraternal or nonprofit entities, free community burial grounds, county cemetery associations, Indian tribal cemeteries on tribal land and charitable or eleemosynary institutions operating cemeteries in this state;
- 20 6. "Outer enclosure" means a grave liner, grave box, or grave
 21 vault;
- 22 7. "Lawn crypt" means a subsurface permanent outer enclosure
 23 installed before need in multiple units for the purpose of interring
 24 human remains;

1	8.7. "Financial institution" means a federally insured bank,
2	trust company, or savings and loan association which is authorized
3	to do business in this state;
4	9. 8. "Commissioner" or "Insurance Commissioner" means the
5	Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma; and
6	$\frac{10.9.}{10.0}$ "Wholesale cost" means an amount determined on the basis
7	of such standard quotations and price lists as are published by the
8	vendor of the cemetery merchandise, without regard to any discounts
9	that may be available to the organization.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
