12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 482, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 482. Physician members of the State Board of Medical
15	Licensure and Supervision shall be appointed for terms of seven (7)
16	years. The lay members of the Board shall serve terms coterminous
17	with that of the Governor and until a qualified successor has been
18	duly appointed and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. No
19	member shall be appointed to serve more than two complete
20	consecutive terms. Each physician member shall hold office until
21	the expiration of the term for which appointed or until a qualified
22	successor has been duly appointed. An appointment shall be made by
23	the Governor within ninety (90) days after the expiration of the
24	term of any member or the occurrence of a vacancy on the Board due

1	to resignation, death, or any cause resulting in an unexpired term.
2	The appointment of allopathic physicians shall be made from a list
3	of three names submitted to the Governor by the Oklahoma State
4	Medical Association. The Association may submit names of members or
5	nonmembers of the Association. No member of the Board shall be a
6	stockholder in or full-time salaried or full-time geographic member
7	of the faculty or board of trustees of any medical school.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
