## AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to religious institutions; prohibiting requirement for certain religious entities or officiants to conduct certain services; prohibiting requirement to allow use of property under certain circumstances; prohibiting consideration of certain property as public accommodation; providing exception; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2102 of Title 25 , unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
A. A church, religious institution or other community or assembly of faith in this state or any minister, elder, deacon or other officiant shall not be required to conduct, preside over, officiate or facilitate a service, ceremony, celebration or other gathering of which the method or purpose violates the doctrine, faith and practice of that organization or group or the method or purpose offends the religious or moral conscience of the requested officiant.
B. A church, religious institution or other community or assembly of faith in this state shall not be required to allow its facilities or property to be used to conduct or facilitate a service, ceremony, celebration or other gathering of which the method or purpose violates its doctrine, faith or practice or the method or purpose offends the religious or moral conscience of the congregation.
C. A church building, auxiliary building or other facility used by a church, religious institution or other community or assembly of faith in this state shall not be considered a public accommodation unless it regularly offers the use of the building or facility to the public on a for profit basis; provided, however, such building or facility shall not be considered a public accommodation for allowing the use of the building or facility by members of the community or community organizations for purposes which do not otherwise violate the doctrine, faith and practice of the congregation or for which the method or purpose does not offend the religious or moral conscience of the congregation.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
