6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
7 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; creating the
8 Oklahoma City National Memorial Education Revolving
9 Fund; making an appropriation; providing for
10 expenditures; providing purpose of fund; providing
11 for codification; providing an effective date; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-34 of Title 2, unless there is
16 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
18 for the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to be
19 designated the "Oklahoma City National Memorial Education Revolving
20 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
21 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
22 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry from
23 legislative appropriations for the purpose of providing curriculum
24 materials and instruction on the April 19, 1995, Alfred P. Murrah
Federal Building bombing to students in this state. All monies

1 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
2 be expended by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
3 Forestry for the purpose provided for in this section.

4 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by
5 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with
6 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
7 approval and payment.

8 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma City
9 National Memorial Education Revolving Fund from any monies not
10 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
11 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, the sum of One
12 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) or so much
13 thereof as necessary for the purpose of providing curriculum
14 materials and instruction on the April 19, 1995, Alfred P. Murrah
15 Federal Building bombing to Oklahoma students.

16 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

17 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
