9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
11 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; creating the
12 Oklahoma City National Memorial Education Revolving
13 Fund; providing for expenditures; providing purpose
14 of fund; providing for codification; providing an
15 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-34 of Title 2, unless there is
19 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
21 for the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to be
22 designated the "Oklahoma City National Memorial Education Revolving
23 Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal
24 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the

1 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry from
2 legislative appropriations for the purpose of providing curriculum
3 materials and instruction on the April 19, 1995, Alfred P. Murrah
4 Federal Building bombing to students in this state. All monies
5 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
6 be expended by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
7 Forestry for the purpose provided for in this section.

8 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by
9 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with
10 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
11 approval and payment.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2024.

13 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
