AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to medical treatment; prohibiting state entity or political subdivision from compelling any medical procedure, use of medical device or wearing of face covering; providing offense; defining term; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3170 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no state entity or political subdivision of this state shall, through direct or indirect means, compel or coerce any person under its jurisdiction to undergo any unwanted medical procedure including, but not limited to, an immunization, to use any unwanted medical device, or to wear any face covering. A person who violates this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. As used in this section, "political subdivision" means a county, city, town, school district, or other local governmental or public entity located within this state.
