4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 256.2 of Title 62, unless there 6 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 7 for the Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority to be 8 9 designated the "Oklahoma Space Industry Development Authority Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Revolving Fund". The fund 10 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, 11 12 and shall consist of all monies appropriated to the Authority from the Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund established in 13 Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes. All monies 14 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may 15 be budgeted and expended by the Authority for the purpose provided 16 for in this section. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon 17 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as 18 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and 19 Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 20

21 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 256.3 of Title 62, unless there 23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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1 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund 2 for the Oklahoma Department of Aerospace and Aeronautics to be designated the "Oklahoma Department of Aerospace and Aeronautics 3 Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Revolving Fund". The fund 4 5 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies appropriated to the Department from 6 the Progressing Rural Economic Prosperity Fund established in 7 Section 256 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes. All monies 8 9 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may 10 be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose provided for in this section. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon 11 12 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of Management and 13 Enterprise Services for approval and payment. 14 SECTION 4.
