6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to Corporation Commission; amending
8 17 O.S. 2011, Section 710.6, which relates to
9 customer information; modifying circumstances in
10 which companies may disclose customer information to
11 third parties; updating statutory reference; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 17 O.S. 2011, Section 710.6, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 710.6. A. An electric utility may provide customer
17 information without customer consent to affiliates and third parties
18 who, under contract, assist the electric utility in providing
19 regulated services or otherwise carrying out its business objectives
20 as outlined in subsection B of Section 4 710.4 of this ~~act~~ title,
21 provided however that the disclosure is limited to the specific
22 information necessary for the third party to carry out its
23 responsibilities to the electric utility. Prior to the disclosure
24 of any customer information to a third party under this subsection,
a responsible representative of the third party shall agree in

1 writing that it will maintain the security and confidentiality of
2 all customer information to which it has access and limit the use of
3 customer information to the provision of such services to the
4 electric utility.

5 B. In addition to providing customer information to affiliates
6 and third parties as described in subsection A of this section,
7 electric utilities may disclose customer information to third
8 parties in the following circumstances:

9 1. As required by law;

10 2. Pursuant to a warrant, subpoena duces tecum, or other court
11 order;

12 3. In the event of a business transaction ~~such as~~ including,
13 but not limited to, a merger, acquisition, sale of assets, or
14 similar transaction involving the electric utility;

15 4. In the event of an emergency situation; or

16 5. When the customer provides written consent to the
17 disclosure.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
