15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
17	Consumer Energy Choice Act".
18	B. For the purposes of this act, "energy source" means any of
19	the following: aviation fuel, biofuel, compressed natural gas,
20	diesel, electricity to be utilized for the charging of electric
21	vehicles, gasoline, gas distillates, hydrogen, liquified petroleum
22	gas, and renewable diesel.
23	C. No city, town, or county shall adopt an ordinance, rule, or
24 27	code which limits consumer access to an energy source or that

1	results in the de facto prohibition of a wholesaler, retailer, or
2	the related infrastructure that is necessary to provide consumer
3	access to a specific energy source within the jurisdiction of a
4	city, town, or county.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
