- C. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive pursuant to subsection B of this section shall be used to offset the increase in benefits provided in subsection A of this section.
- D. Effective July 1, 2019, any persons receiving benefits pursuant to Section 49-101 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall each receive a benefit equal to Eight Dollars and thirteen cents (\$8.13) for each year of credited service not to exceed thirty (30) years of service.
