9 An Act relating to polling places; providing for
10 additional polling places for certain precincts;
11 authorizing maintenance and cleaning fee for certain
 facilities; providing for codification; providing an
 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-120.1 of Title 26, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. For elections to be held after July 1, 2022, any state
19 agency, board, or commission that owns or leases a facility located
20 in or near a precinct without a suitable polling place available,
21 shall make space within the facility available for use as a polling
22 place upon the written request of the secretary of the county
23 election board.

1 B. For elections to be held after July 1, 2022, any political
2 subdivision of this state that held an election that was conducted
3 by a county election board on or after January 1, 2018, and that
4 owns, rents, or leases a facility located in or near a precinct
5 without a suitable polling place available, shall make space within
6 the facility available for use as a polling place upon the written
7 request of the secretary of the county election board.

8 C. For facilities described in subsection A or B of this
9 section, a reasonable maintenance or cleaning fee may be charged to
10 the county election board for use of the facility as a polling
11 place.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

13 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
