14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
16	This act shall be known and cited as the "Constitutional
17	Heritage and Legacy Display Act".
18	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 230 of Title 61, unless there is
20	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
21	A. If funds under subsection C of this section are available,
22	local school superintendents of the public schools in this state and
23	the administrative officials of state agencies shall place a durable
24	poster or framed image representing:

- 1 | 1. The national motto of the United States, "In God We Trust";
- 2 2. An accurate representation of the United States flag, which 3 shall be centered under the national motto;
  - 3. An accurate representation of the Oklahoma State flag;
  - 4. The United States Declaration of Independence;
  - 5. The United States Bill of Rights; and
  - 6. The Constitution of the United States.
  - B. These items shall be displayed in each:
- 9 1. Public elementary and secondary school library and classroom
  10 in this state; and
- 2. Public building or facility in this state that is maintained or operated by state funds.
- C. The items and images authorized under this section shall either be donated or shall be purchased solely with funds made available through voluntary contributions to state agencies, local schools, or local school boards. The items and images authorized under this section may be displayed as they are donated or purchased.
- 19 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
