hearing, any such bill or resolution shall receive a vote of the

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- committee if a motion for such a vote is properly made and seconded according to the rules of that house of the Legislature.
- B. Any bill or resolution reported from a committee to the full Senate, or referred directly to the calendar of the Senate, shall be scheduled for floor consideration in the Senate if the principal Senate author of the measure makes such a request in writing to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate. Any bill or resolution reported from a committee to the full House of Representatives, or referred directly to the calendar of the House of Representatives, shall be scheduled for floor consideration in the House of Representatives if the principal House author of the measure makes such a request in writing to the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Any such bill or resolution shall receive a vote of the full Senate or House of Representatives if a motion for such a vote is properly made and seconded according to the rules of that house of the Legislature.
 - C. Each house of the Legislature shall have the authority to set forth a minimum number of measures principally authored by each member of that house during each regular session which shall receive consideration by that house, which shall not be fewer than three, unless a member is the principal author of fewer measures than such minimum number.
