8 An Act relating to municipalities; requiring  
9 municipalities with certain homeless camps to conduct  
10 building inspections; stating that municipalities  
11 shall be liable for harm in certain areas; providing  
12 for codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 22-140 of Title 11, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 All municipalities shall have thirty (30) days to conduct  
18 inspections of homeless camps in municipal districts that have water  
19 run-off enter municipal sewer systems, drainage systems, or drinking  
20 water reservoirs. The homeless camps shall be up to building codes  
21 established by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission. Any  
22 municipalities that do not inspect the homeless camps within the  
23 thirty-day period shall be liable for any harm within and outside of  
24 the immediate boundaries of the homeless camp. If the homeless camp

1 does not meet building codes in the thirty-day period, the  
2 municipality shall abolish the camp.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.

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
