11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 22-140 of Title 11, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 All municipalities shall have thirty (30) days to conduct  
16 inspections of homeless camps in municipal districts that have water  
17 run-off enter municipal sewer systems, drainage systems, or drinking  
18 water reservoirs. The homeless camps shall be up to building codes  
19 established by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission. Any  
20 municipalities that do not inspect the homeless camps within the  
21 thirty-day period shall be liable for any harm within and outside of  
22 the immediate boundaries of the homeless camp. If the homeless camp  
23 does not meet building codes in the thirty-day period, the  
24 municipality shall abolish the camp.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
