12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 291.4 of Title 74, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. For the purposes of this section, "state officers" shall
17	mean the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Attorney General,
18	the Superintendent of Public Instruction, members of the Corporation
19	Commission, the State Treasurer, the State Auditor and Inspector,
20	the Insurance Commissioner, and the Commissioner of Labor.
21	B. State officers shall be allowed a per diem in lieu of
22	expenses in an amount authorized by the provisions of the Internal
23	Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, for deductibility of expenses for

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travel while away from home without additional documentation for

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    each night spent away from home in the performance of their official
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    duties within the state, in addition to the provisions of the State
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    Travel Reimbursement Act.
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        C. State officers, while performing official duties, shall be
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    entitled to receive reimbursement for mileage and per diem in the
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    same manner as provided for in Sections 291.1 and 291.1a of this
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    title, in addition to the provisions of the State Travel
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    Reimbursement Act.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
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
