Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in addition to 18 any appointments created by expiring terms or vacancies provided by 19 20 law, the Governor shall have the power to remove any gubernatorial appointments on any agency, board or commission at any time, subject 21 to the provisions of this section. Nothing in this section shall 22 23 apply to appointments to any agency, board or commission if the appointing authority is provided for in the Constitution. A vacancy 24

NEW LAW 4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 464.1 of Title 74, unless there 5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in addition to any 6 7 appointments created by expiring terms or vacancies provided by law, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House 8 9 of Representatives shall have the power to remove any of their 10 respective appointments on any agency, board or commission at any 11 time, subject to the provisions of this section. Nothing in this 12 section shall apply to appointments to any agency, board or 13 commission if the appointing authority is provided for in the Constitution. A vacancy created pursuant to the provisions of this 14 section shall be filled as provided by law. 15 16 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 18 19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 20 21 22
