13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 65 of Title 73, unless there is
15	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. In keeping with the tradition established by the display of
17	the national motto in the Tourist Information Center of the United
18	States Capitol Building, the administrator of the Office of
19	Management and Enterprise Services shall utilize monies from the
20	Oklahoma State Capitol Building Repair and Restoration Fund to
21	create an inscription of the national motto of the United States in
22	a prominently visible location in the visitor center of the Oklahoma
23	State Canitol Building The placement and size of the display shall

be in keeping with the placement and size of the display of the

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national motto in the Tourist Information Center of the United States Capitol Building.

- B. In the event that the legality or constitutionality of the inscription is challenged in a court of law, the Oklahoma Attorney General or Liberty Legal Institute is hereby authorized to prepare and present a legal defense of the inscription.
- C. The placement of this inscription shall not be construed to mean that the State of Oklahoma favors any particular religion or denomination thereof over others.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
