20	B. The salary bonus shall not be included for the purposes of

C. For purposes of this section:

1	1. "Salary bonus" means additional monies granted to a teacher,
2	who is employed as a teacher in a high poverty school;
3	2. "High poverty school" means a public school or brick and
4	mortar charter school in which seventy percent (70%) or more of the
5	enrolled students qualify for free or reduced lunch.
6	D. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules
7	necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
8	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.
9	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
