13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 12 O.S. 2021, Section 683, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 683. Except as provided in Section 684.1 684 of this
17	title, an action may be dismissed, without prejudice to a future
18	action:
19	1. By the plaintiff, before the final submission of the case to
20	the jury, or to the court, where the trial is by the court;
21	2. By the court, where the plaintiff fails to appear on the
22	trial;
23	$\frac{3.}{2.}$ By the court, for the want of necessary parties;

- 4. 3. By the court, on the application of some of the defendants, where there are others whom the plaintiff fails to prosecute with diligence;
- $\frac{5.}{4.}$  By the court, for disobedience by the plaintiff of an order concerning the proceedings in the action; and
- $\frac{6.}{5.}$  In all other cases, upon the trial of the action, the decision must be upon the merits.
- SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 12 O.S. 2021, Section 684, is amended to read as follows:
- Section 684. A. Am Subject to subsection E of Section 2023 and Sections 2023.1 and 2023.2 of this title or any applicable state or federal statute, an action may be dismissed by the plaintiff without an order of court by filing a notice of dismissal at any time before pretrial. After the pretrial hearing, an action may only be dismissed by agreement of the parties or by the court before the opposing party serves an answer or a motion for summary judgment. Unless otherwise stated in the notice of dismissal or stipulation, the dismissal is without prejudice. If the plaintiff previously dismissed any action in federal or state court based on or including the same claim, a notice of dismissal shall operate as an adjudication on the merits.
- B. Except as provided in subsection A of this section, an action shall not be dismissed at the plaintiff's request except upon order of the court and upon such terms and conditions as the court

deems proper. If a counterclaim has been pleaded by a defendant prior to the service upon the defendant of the plaintiff's motion to dismiss, the action shall not be dismissed against the defendant's objection unless the counterclaims can remain pending for independent adjudication by the court. Unless otherwise specified in the order, a dismissal under this subsection is without prejudice.

- C. For failure of the plaintiff to prosecute or to comply with the provisions of this section or any order of court, a defendant may move for dismissal of an action or of any claim against the defendant. Unless the dismissal order states otherwise, a dismissal under this subsection or under any other section of law, except for lack of jurisdiction, improper venue, or failure to join a party under Section 2019 of this title, shall operate as an adjudication on the merits.
- D. The provisions of this section apply to the dismissal of any counterclaim, cross-claim, or third-party claim. A voluntary dismissal by the claimant alone pursuant to subsection A of this section shall be made before a responsive pleading is served or, if there is none, before the introduction of evidence at the trial or hearing.

If a plaintiff who has once dismissed an action in any court commences an action based upon or including the same claim against the same defendant, the court may make such order for the payment of
