18	Section 80.8. To file as a candidate for the State Senate in
19	any senatorial district, a person must have been a registered voter
20	in the district and a resident residing within such district for the
21	six-month period immediately preceding the first day of the filing
22	period as provided by law. Provided, however, to file as a
23	candidate for the Senate in any Senate district in 2022, a person
24	must have been a registered voter and a resident residing in such
