A. In addition to other vehicle registration 16 fees specified by law, there is levied and there shall be paid to 17 the Oklahoma Tax Commission a fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) upon 18 every motorcycle registered pursuant to Section 1132 of Title 47 of 19 the Oklahoma Statutes this title for use on roads and highways. 20 fee shall accrue and shall be collectible upon each motorcycle 21 registered for use on roads and highways under the same 22 circumstances and shall be payable in the same manner and times as 23 apply to the registration of motorcycles for use on roads and 24

- highways under the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act; provided, the fee shall be paid in full for the
- 3 then current year at the time any vehicle is first registered in a
- 4 | calendar year.
- 5 B. Revenue from the fee levied in subsection A of this section
- 6 | shall be transferred each month to the Department of Public Safety
- 7 | for deposit in the Motorcycle Safety and Education Program Revolving
- 8 | Fund created pursuant to Section 40-123 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
- 9 | Statutes this title; provided, in no event shall the revenue
- 10 apportioned pursuant to this section exceed the 3-year average of
- 11 the total fiscal year amounts apportioned in fiscal years 2015, 2016
- 12 and 2017. Any amount in excess of the 3-year average shall be
- 13 | placed to the credit of the General Revenue Fund.
- 14 C. The collection and payment of the fee specified in this
- 15 | section shall be a prerequisite to licensing or registration of any
- 16 motorcycle.
- 17 | SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
- 18 | SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
- 19 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
- 20 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
- 21 | be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
