14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1-133.3, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1-133.3. Motorized scooter. A. A "motorized scooter"
17	is any vehicle having:
18	1. Not more than three wheels in contact with the ground;
19	2. Handlebars and a foot support or seat for the use of the
20	operator; and
21	3. A power source that is capable of propelling the vehicle at
22	a maximum design speed of not more than twenty-five (25) thirty (30)
23	miles per hour on level ground, and:

- 1a.if the power source is a combustion engine, has a2piston or rotor displacement of thirty-five fifty3cubic centimeters (35 cu cm) (50 cu cm) or less4regardless of the number of chambers in the power5source, or
- b. if the power source is electric, has a power output of
 not more than one thousand (1,000) watts is programmed
 by the manufacturer not to exceed thirty (30) miles
 per hour on level ground.

B. For purposes of this section, an electric personal assistive
mobility device, as defined in Section 1-114A of this title,
bicycle, electric-assisted bicycle, or motorized bicycle, as defined
in Section 1-104 of this title, shall not be considered a motorized
scooter.

C. A motorized scooter shall not be required to be registered
under the laws of this state. The operator of a motorized scooter
shall <u>be at least fourteen (14) years of age and shall</u> not be
required to possess a driver license or to comply with the vehicle
insurance or financial responsibility laws of this state <u>and shall</u>
<u>observe all applicable traffic safety regulations</u>.
SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
